Professor Neil Johnson CREI is the Medical Director of Flinders Fertility. He is also a Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at Flinders University and has honorary academic appointments at the University of Auckland, NZ, and the University of Adelaide. His research interests include the fertility aspects of endometriosis (for which he has pioneered the use of Lipiodol in A/NZ), and polycystic ovarian syndrome. Professor Johnson is seeing private patients at Flinders Fertility who have a history of complex or unexplained infertility and a confirmed diagnosis of endometriosis.
